Classroom Sessions

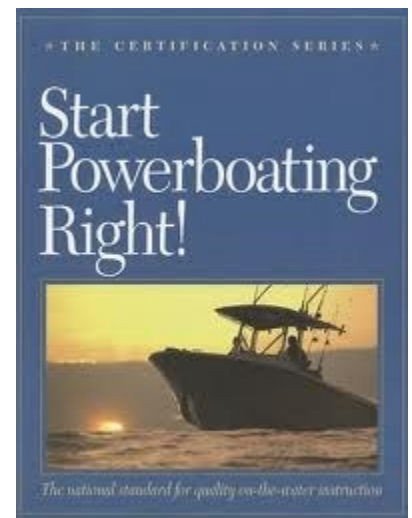
- Safety, prep & weather
